


CUf Oncologia





The cancer patient's journey doesn't finish with the end of treatment, and survivorship should be CUF's next focus...

It is estimated that the number of cancer survivors in Europe is now over 12 million.

Cancer survivors face their own challenges as a result of the disease and when returning to active life.

As a leading healthcare institution, we believe that CUF should set the standards in survivorship care in Portugal.



We aim to create a Survivorship and Integrative Oncology Clinic to meet the needs of patients from diagnosis...

Target: cancer patients, internal or external to CUF, from the moment of diagnosis

Scope of action:

- Support in managing the stress of a cancer diagnosis and at the beginning of the treatment journey;
- Support for cancer patients undergoing treatment, in managing their side effects, as well as the need for support from specialists not directly related to cancer treatment, from support areas such as Psychology and Nutrition, or from scientifically proven complementary therapies, combining conventional medicine with evidence-based complementary treatments.
- Support for patients who have already been treated, both in terms of treating their sequelae and in terms of prevention, promoting healthy lifestyles and adapting to life after cancer.
- Involvement and literacy of the entire cancer patient ecosystem for life after a cancer diagnosis.



... Gathering and structuring the offer CUF currently has in a Clinic, and extending the offer to cancer survivor's needs

Cluster Organization: core teams in each Cluster, based on the main hospitals (Porto, Tejo and Descobertas), will be responsible for managing the Unit in that Cluster, and for creating bridges with the different areas of activity.

- Core Team will consist of an Oncologist (coordinator) and a nurse, per Cluster
- Extended team will consist of healthcare professionals from different areas who are reference in treating cancer patients and cancer treatment's sequels or toxicities
- Educational programs will be powered by CUF Academic Center



Supported on 4 pillars of action...

01

Clinical and integrative offer: aiming to provide support in medical areas, support areas or scientifically proven complementary areas, by clinical teams specialized in supporting cancer patients or cancer survivors.

02

Education and Literacy on cancer: aiming to educate all audiences about issues related to cancer, including prevention, risks, treatment, survival and end-of-life care through educational programs and support for cancer patients, their caregivers, clinical teams and the public.

03

Patient Advocacy: aiming to create awareness about people with cancer in the various stages of their illness, from diagnosis to life after cancer, targeting the general population and employers.

Research: aiming to contribute to scientific bases that support the importance of monitoring cancer survivors, and highlight the gains for patients with this monitoring, in the Portuguese reality.
