2072 notifications

Alerts received through the network on measures taken regarding a dangerous product.

2745 follow-up actions

Information received on follow-up actions taken in other network countries concerning dangerous products, in response to a notification.



The Rapid Alert System for dangerous nonfood products operates through a network of 31 countries, who exchange information on products that pose a risk to consumers, and on the measures taken to mitigate this risk and protect consumers.






ONE EUROPE-WIDE ALERT SYSTEM, SAFER PRODUCTS



Public authorities including border officials, manufacturers, retailers, importers and distributors, work together to keep consumers safe




What happens across Europe when an alert is sent through the Rapid Alert System


