

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Objectives and activities of the Plan

Objective: education, support and strengthening the role of informal caregivers

Objective: enabling people with dementia in staying at home

- Activity: To increase the network density of the advisory centers
- Activity: Every person living with dementia receives an individual care plan where care sharing is stressed
- Activity: Informal caregivers, their education and support are recognized as a target group and as a service by law (108/2006 Coll.)
- Activity: To map educational needs and preferences of informal caregivers and to support forms of education that meet these needs
- Activity: To create a website dedicated to dementia
- Activity: To stimulate formation of self-help groups in communities
- Activity: Support of natural resources available to informal caregivers
